

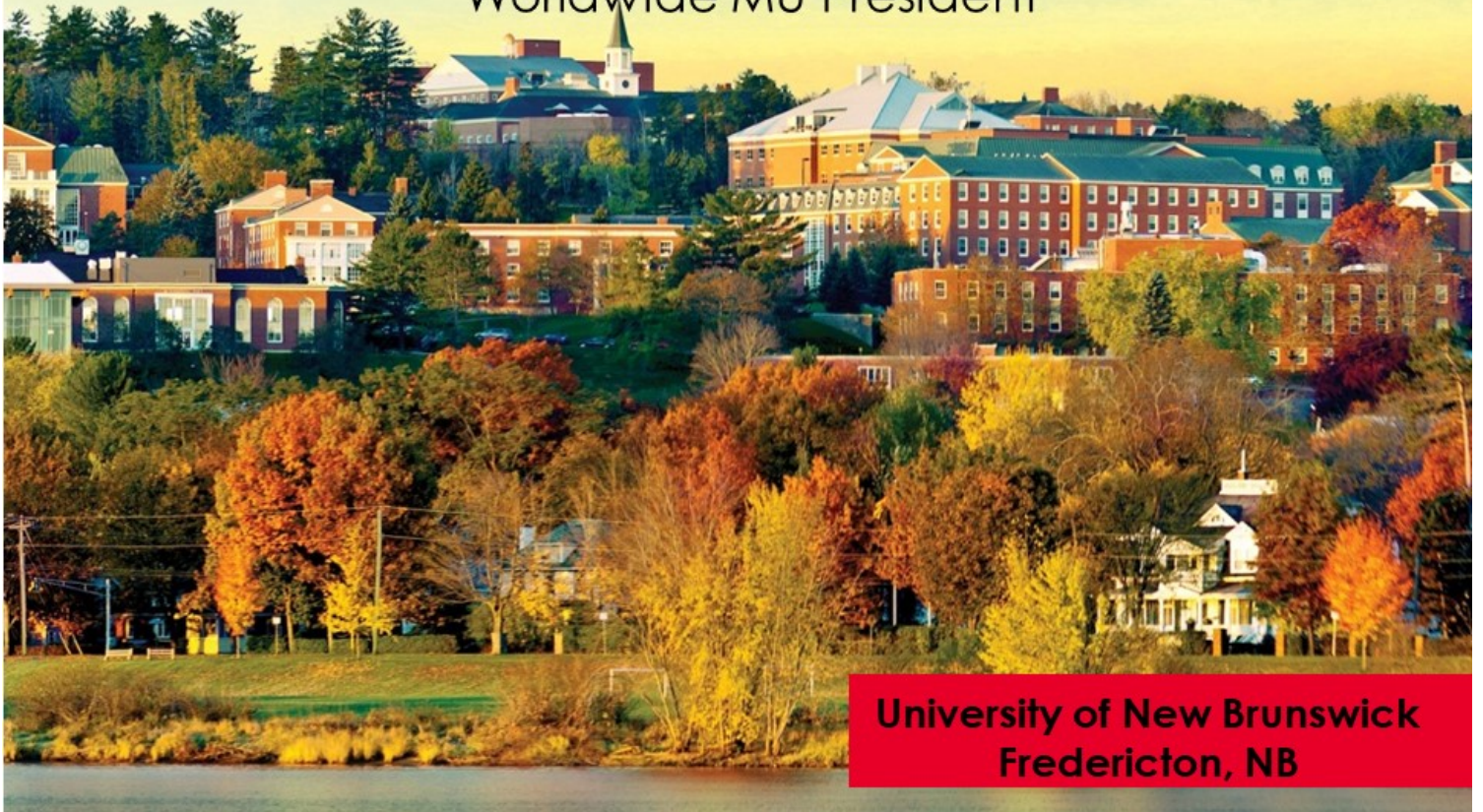

| 1. <b>Saint John River Cruise</b> (duration 2 hours) - Wolastoq Tour Boat: a scenic boat cruise on the majestic Saint John River in a relaxing way to see the city and enjoy the afternoon. Snacks and drinks available at a cost.   | \$30        |
| 2. <b>Beaverbrook Art Gallery</b> (duration 2 hours) - Named after William Maxwell Aitken, Lord Beaverbrook, and includes works by famous Canadian artists, local artists as well as many paintings by famous international artists such as J.M.W. Turner and Salvador Dali. The New Brunswick Craft College is also nearby. There will be additional time for shopping in local shops following the tour. | \$20        |
| 3. <b>Government House</b> (duration 2 hours) - This national and provincial historic site is the residence and office of the province’s Lieutenant Governor. Rooms are filled with period antiques made by some of the best craftsmen in North America. Many items have links to the province’s three founding cultures. Shopping at local shops available following the tour.                            | \$10        |
| 4. <b>Christ Church Cathedral Guided Tour</b> (duration 60 minutes) - The Cathedral is a National Historic Site, constructed and completed in 1853. It is one of the finest examples of decorated Gothic architecture in North America, followed by shopping in quaint shops nearby (Urban Threadz, Botanicals, Gallery 78) throughout the downtown.   | \$10        |
