\$10 Facilitator Workbooks

These books will be used as part of a Parents Supporting Parents facilitator course in Canada's North.



The first facilitator training session has been held in Moosonee Diocese with 9 people attending. They were from communities in Northern Quebec. Now they are equipped to facilitate a course in either French, English or Cree as needed in their home communities.



Confidence Building

\$15 could help give women in Rwanda the skills and confidence to speak and lead. Increasing women's voice and agency has been proven to increase their ability to make decisions and take advantage of opportunities that can improve their communities.
